

*The .eu domains Registration Guide
for the special telecommunications networks users,
as provided by Law 92/1996*

This procedure describes how to register the .eu domains for the special telecommunications networks users, as provided by Law 92/1996. This service can be accessed at www.stsnet.ro, .eu domains section. In order to register a domain name, some steps are to be followed:

1. Before submitting an application for a Domain Name registration, the Client must check whether the domain name in question meets the conditions:

- Availability conditions:
 - it is not already registered as a Domain Name;
 - it is not reserved, blocked or suspended.
- Technical and lexical conditions:
 - are a minimum of 2 characters long *before* their conversion into the ACE notation (not including the .eu suffix), are a maximum of 63 characters long *after* their conversion into the ACE notation (not including the .eu suffix) and after the conversion of capitals into small letters;
 - use characters selected from the list of supported characters in the Latin, Greek and Cyrillic scripts, as published on the website of the Registry;
 - contain letters from a single script only;
 - do not begin or end with the hyphen ("-");
 - do not contain a hyphen ("-") in the third and fourth positions simultaneously, unless they begin with the characters "xn" or also contain a hyphen in the second position;
 - may not consist exclusively of an alpha-2 country code;
 - may not contain any characters other than the Latin letters "A" to "Z" or "a" to "z", the digits "0" to "9" or the hyphen ("-") if they begin with the characters "xn--".

N.B.

Checking the domain name's availability through the medium of WHOIS search engine can be carried out at www.stsnet.ro, .eu domain section.

2. The Client must read and decide whether he agrees with the following:

- The .eu domain name Registration Policy;
- The .eu domain name registration terms and conditions.

3. After choosing the .eu domain name, the Client fills in the domain registration form, requesting STS to register the .eu domain name with EURid. This form will contain details as follows:

- The name of a contact person for technical matters;
- The contact person's position;
- The organization name;
- The organization address;
- Telephone and fax numbers (the fax number is not mandatory);
- The e-mail address to which the registration confirmation, as well as other information, are to be sent (the Client guarantees that this address is functional);
- Names of DNS servers and their IP addresses – when the Client has its own DNS server or uses the services of another Internet services provider;
- The Client is free to use the DNS server provided by STS;
- The Client will mention in the registration form that he has read and accepted "The .eu domain name Registration Policy" and "The .eu domain name registration terms and conditions".

N.B.

This information about the Client is mandatory for the domain registration with EURid. The information will be registered in the WHOIS database and can be accessed by whoever wants to check the status of a .eu domain.

4. The request, automatically generated in pdf and received by STS by e-mail as a filled-in form, must be printed out, signed, stamped, officially registered and sent via postal services (in maximum 5 days after filling in) and, in order to be efficient, it can be sent by fax (021.2234150 or 021.3131884) or, after scanning, by e-mail to domeniieu@stsnet.ro.

5. STS will register the domain requested by the Client in maximum 24 hours after receiving the registration form via postal services and for 1 year period (which can be renewed). STS will send an e-mail to the Client contact person to confirm the registration of the .eu Domain Name.

N.B.:

Correcting a Domain Name error is not possible once registered.

6. In case the contact details of the Client (name and position of the contact person, name, address, phone/fax numbers and e-mail of the organization) are to be changed, within 1 (one) month as from the date of the respective modification the aforementioned Client must request STS to update the information in the database.

7. The Domain Name is automatically renewed for consecutive periods of 1 (one) year each. If the Client doesn't want to renew the Domain Name after the 1 (one) year validity period expiration, STS must be notified within minimum 1 (one) month before the expiration date.
